DISASTER SUPPLIES

- **Water:** At least 2 gallons daily per person for 14 days
- **Food:** At least enough for 14 days
- non perishable packaged or canned food/juices
- foods for infants or the elderly
- snack foods
- non-electric can opener
- cooking tools/fuel
- paper plates/plastic utensils
- Lots of ice (freeze your water supply)
- **Blankets/Pillows, etc.:** ...Sleeping bags and/or air mattresses.
- **Clothing:** Seasonal/rain gear/sturdy shoes/extra eyeglasses/Sunglasses
- **Special Items:** For babies and the elderly
- **Toiletries:** Hygiene items/ toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, moisture wipes, contact solution etc.
- **Flashlight/Extra Batteries**
- **Radio:** Battery operated and NOAA Weather Radio
- **Cash:** Banks and ATMs may not be open or available for extended periods
- **Keys**
- **Toys, Books and Games:** Quiet games, books, playing cards and favorite toys for children
- **Tools:** Keep a small set with you during the storm
- **Vehicle fuel tanks filled**
- **Pet care items**
 - Proper identification/immunization records
 - Ample supply of food and water
 - A carrier or cage
 - Medications
 - Muzzle and leash
- **First Aid Kit:**
 - Medicines/Prescription Drugs
 - Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes
 - 2 & 4 inch sterile gauze pads (4-6 each)
 - Hypoallergenic adhesive tape
 - 2 & 3 inch sterile roller bandages (3 rolls each)
 - Scissors, Tweezers, Needle
 - Moistened towlettes
 - Antiseptic
 - Thermometer
 - Tube of petroleum jelly or other lubricant
 - Cleansing agent/sop
 - 2 pairs latex gloves
 - Sunscreen
 - Non prescription drugs
 - Aspirin or non-aspirin pain reliever
 - Anti-diarrhea medication
 - Antacid (for stomach upset)
 - Syrup of Ipecac (use - to induce vomiting if advised by Poison Control Center)
 - Laxative
 - Activated charcoal (use if advised by the Poison Control Center)
- **Important documents: In a waterproof container:**
 - Insurance, medical records, bank account numbers, social security card, etc.
 - Wills, contracts, deeds, stocks & Bonds
 - Passports, immunization records
 - Credit card account numbers & companies
 - Family records: birth, marriage, death certificates
 - Document all valuables with videotape if possible

Please keep in mind that **IF** you plan on staying in your home:

- ☐ Remove ALL items from outside. During a storm these become projectiles.
- ☐ Stay away from windows during the storm.
- ☐ Should you loose power, shut your main breaker off until service is resumed and safe.
- ☐ Stay away from ANY fallen wires.
- ☐ Keep pets within reach should your property experience damage (broken windows, etc.)
- ☐ IF USING CANDLES: **NEVER leave the area while lit.**
- ☐ Make a list of Service people for after the storm;
 - **Tree Services**
 - **Roofing Company**
 - **Electrician**
 - **Electric Company**
 - **Water Company**
 - **Any other services you may need for property damages**
