# HOME OWNER MAINTENANCE TIPS

Forced hot air in your home may become very dry. And for the comfort of your family, you may wish to add some moisture to it. This is normally done with a humidifier.

Experts suggest that when placing this humidifier, home owners should not place it directly over the furnace heat exchange.

### INSTALLATION

If the humidifier is not kept clean, or if water leaks, it can flow into the furnace causing a hole. These conditions ongoing and unchecked can mean the furnace will need to be replaced.

It is preferred to put the humidifier on duct work away from the furnace. It is also preferred that owners use the evaporation type of humidifier, as opposed to the spray type, because the evaporator type is more easily maintained.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

Remember, that all humidifiers need routine maintenance and checking. Take care that these don't become some of the most neglected appliances in your house.
