Boating Regulations

The following are the regulations of the Texas Water Safety Act as listed on the Texas Parks and Wildlife website, www.tpwd.state.tx.us

TEXAS REGISTRATION AND TITLE

All motorboats and all sailboats 14 feet in length or longer operated on public waters or docked, moored, or stored on public water must be currently registered, properly displaying authorized numbers and validation decal, and titled. All outboard motors must be titled. Title applications and manufacturers statement of origin must accompany a request for boat registration for new boats and outboard motors.

Exemptions – All canoes, kayaks, punts, rowboats or rubber rafts (regardless of length) when paddled, poled, or oared and sailboats under 14 feet in length when windblown.

TEXAS CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER


When a vessel which is required to be registered is in operation, the certificate of number (registration) or facsimile thereof must always be aboard and available for inspection by an enforcement officer. The certificate is valid until the expiration date shown thereon. When a certificate is renewed the same number shall be reissued, if application to the Department is made within the 90 day period preceding the expiration date.

DISPLAY OF YOUR NUMBER

The number awarded a vessel must be painted on, or otherwise attached to each side of the vessel, near the bow, in such position as to provide easy identification. The number shall read from left to right, be in block characters of good proportion not less than three inches in height and be of a color that contrasts with the background. The numerals must be separated from the prefix and the suffix by hyphens or equivalent spaces such as the following example: TX 0123 AB and TX-0123-AB. Federal and state law prohibits any other number from being displayed on either side of the bow of your boat. The validation decal must be affixed in a line with and three (3) inches towards the rear of the boat from the registration number.

LIFESAVING DEVICES

All Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's) must be U.S. Coast Guard approved, in serviceable condition, readily accessible, and of the appropriate size for intended user. All children under 13 years of age in motorboats under 26 feet in length must wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal floatation device while underway. Underway means not at anchor, made fast to the shore, or aground.



All vessels, including canoes and kayaks, must be equipped with one Type I, II, III or V wearable PFD for each person on board. A Type V PFD is acceptable only if used in accordance with the specific instructions on the label of the device. Vessels 16 feet and longer, excluding canoes and kayaks, are required to be equipped with one Type IV throwable Personal Flotation Device in addition to the Type I, II, III, or V PFD required for each person on board.

Inflatable PFDs are authorized only when used in accordance with requirements as presented on U.S. Coast Guard approval labels. Inflatable PFDs are not approved for use on personal watercraft, waterskiing, or other high speed activity.

PERSONAL WATERCRAFT

Personal watercraft is defined as a type of motorboat which is specifically designed to be operated by a person or persons sitting, standing, or kneeling ON the vessel rather than INSIDE the vessel. Includes jet skis, wet bikes, etc.


REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT FOR PERSONAL WATERCRAFT

All equipment requirements for regular motorboats also apply to personal watercraft. In addition to those requirements, if the personal watercraft is equipped with a cut-off or kill switch, it must be attached to operator or operator's clothing. Inflatable personal floatation devices are not approved for use on personal watercraft.

OPERATION OF YOUR PERSONAL WATERCRAFT

NOTE: Children under 13 are specifically prohibited from operating a personal watercraft unless accompanied on board by a person at least 18 years of age.

All operational rules for regular motorboats also apply to personal watercraft. In addition those requirements, it is unlawful for any person to (1) operate a personal watercraft if the operator is under 16 years of age, unless the operator is accompanied by a person at least 18 years of age or is at least 13 years of age and has successfully completed a boating safety course prescribed and approved by the Department; (2) operate personal watercraft at night (sunset until sunrise); (3) operate personal watercraft within 50 feet of another personal watercraft, motorboat, vessel, platform, person, object, or shore except at headway speed without creating a swell or wake; (4) operate a personal watercraft and jump the wake of another vessel recklessly or unnecessarily close.



The Highland Lakes

The Highland Lakes of Central Texas consist of 7 lakes along the Colorado River starting 85 miles northwest of Austin and ending in Austin. These lakes are very popular with boaters and fishermen as well as campers and tourists. This is also a very popular retirement area. There are special features and services at all of the lakes (see below).

Lake Buchanan

Lake Buchanan is the largest of the first four Highland Lakes in Central Texas with a length of 30 miles and a width at the widest point of just under 5 miles. The lake has a shoreline of 124 miles. When it was built, Buchanan Dam was considered to be the longest multiple-arch dam in the U.S. with a length of just over two miles. There are three towns close to Lake Buchanan. Burnet is 15 miles to the east of Inks Lake. Kingsland is 6 miles south and Llano is 15 miles to the west. Lake Buchanan is located 60 miles northwest of Austin and 95 miles north of San Antonio. It is about 200 miles south of Dallas and Fort Worth and 200 miles west of Houston.

Inks Lake

Located 55 miles northwest of Austin on Highway 29, Inks Lake is the next lake down the Colorado River from Lake Buchanan. It starts just a short distance from the base of Buchanan Dam. With a length of 4.2 miles and a width of 3,000 feet, Inks Lake is the shortest of the first four lakes but is also one of the prettiest. There are three towns close to Inks Lake. Burnet is 14 miles to the east of Inks Lake. Kingsland is 7 miles south and Llano is 17 miles to the west.

Lake LBJ

Lake LBJ, named after President Lyndon B. Johnson, starts near Horseshoe Bay, 45 miles from Austin, and goes all the way to Kingsland. Lake LBJ is mostly a constant level lake and is just over 21 miles long with a maximum width of 10,800 feet. The shores of the lake are dotted with nice homes with boat houses and automatic boat lifts. There are several communities along the lake: Kingsland, Highland Haven, Granite Shoals, Sunrise Beach, Deer Haven, Blue Lake and Horseshoe Bay. Lake LBJ is a great retirement area as well as a recreational area. This area has been rated in the top three areas of the U.S. for retirement.

Lake Marble Falls

Lake Marble Falls is the 4th lake in the Highland Lakes string. Lake Marble Falls is popular for boating, and waterskiing. It is 5.75 miles long and 1,080 feet wide in the widest area. Lake Marble Falls is located at the booming town of Marble Falls about 45 miles northwest of Austin. It can be reached from Austin by driving out Highway 71 and then north on Highway 281, or by going west on Highway 1431 out of Cedar Park on the north edge of Austin. Meadowlakes, a gated golfing community, is located on the shores of Lake Marble Falls adjacent to the town of Marble Falls.

Lake Travis

Lake Travis is the fifth lake down in the chain of Highland Lakes. Starting at Austin, Lake Travis winds its way northwest through the central Texas Hill Country for over 60 miles. It is the longest of the 7 Highland Lakes and is very popular for boating. At the widest point the lake is 4.5 miles wide. Until recently the Joseph James Mansfield dam was part of Hwy 620 and traffic drove over the top of the dam. A large bridge has now been built to route the traffic on Hwy 620 down below the dam. There are four communities located around the shores of Lake Travis. On the south side of Lake Travis, closer to Austin, on Hwy 620 is the Golfing community of Lakeway. On the north side of the lake are two communities; Lago Vista, another Golfing community, and Jonestown. Both of these communities are on Hwy. 1431. On the northwest side of Lake Travis is the community of Briarcliff. It is directly across the lake from Lago Vista. It can be reached by taking Hwy 2322 east from Hwy 71.

Lake Austin

Lake Austin is the sixth lake down in the chain of Highland Lakes. The lake starts at the Mansfield Dam and ends at the Tom Miller Dam in the city of Austin. The Bridge on Hwy 360, which goes over Lake Austin, is a good point for launching your boat. It is also a popular gathering point on the lake. Lake Austin has high cliffs in places along the shore of the lake which provide shelter from the wind for the best in boating activities. The cliffs are dotted with expensive homes overlooking the lake.

Town Lake

Town Lake is in the city of Austin, Texas. Town Lake runs between Riverside Drive and 1st Street in the downtown area of Austin. Interstate I-35 goes over Town Lake as you are driving through Austin. Town Lake is the last lake in the Highland Lakes chain of seven lakes in the Texas Hill Country. All seven lakes are different and offer different scenery and amenities. Town Lake is a placid lake and is a constant level lake, ideal for canoeing. You will find easy access to the lake from the parks along the shore. Tourists and local residents enjoy canoeing on Town Lake. You can take a nice long walk along the lake or do a little jogging along the

Hunting Licenses: A hunting license is required of any person, regardless of age, who hunts in Texas. Residents under 17 years or over 65 years of age do not need a regular hunting license, but must have a \$6 Special Resident Hunting License.

Fees: Resident General Hunting, \$13 Nonresident General Hunting, \$250 Nonresident Special Hunting, \$100

Nonresident Spring Turkey, \$100 Nonresident 5-day Special, \$35

Fishing Licenses: For residents of Texas, only those between the ages of 17 and 65 years of age are required to have a fishing license. However, a fishing license is required for all nonresident fishermen.




The first Saturday in June of each year is the annual Free Sportfishing Day and no person is required to have a fishing license or stamps while sportfishing on that day. Resident Combination Hunting and Fishing, \$25 – valid for both hunting and fishing for Texas residents only.

Note: While hunting, fishing or trapping, persons 17 years of age or older must carry on their person a driver's license or personal identification certificate issued by the Department of Public Safety. Nonresidents must carry similar documents issued by the agency in their state or country of residence that is authorized to issue driver's licenses or personal identification certificates.
