## 6 Green Alternatives to Household Chemicals

- Chrome Polish -> Apple Cider Vinegar
- Drain Cleaner -> 1/2 c. Baking Soda, 1/2 c. Vinegar, follow with 2 quarts Boiling Water. Repeat.
- Linoleum cleaner -> 1 c. White Vinegar + 2 gallons of Water
- Roach Repellent -> Chopped Bay Leaves and Cucumber Skins
- Carpet Cleaner -> Baking Soda
