Donated by a builder when Darlington Commons was under construction, the Darlington Nature Trail is a one-acre walking/nature trail between the end of Burke Road and Darlington Circle at Darlington Commons Court. The Darlington Nature Trail is bordered with split rails and covered with natural wood mulch. Along the nature trail informational signs identifying the plant life and trees, as well as birdwatching spots are present so that visitors can stop, learn and listen. Workout stations allow for exercising within nature. There's even a picnic area for you to rest and enjoy a snack or picnic lunch. It's a great place for walking the dog, pushing the stroller, jogging or enjoying nature.
